


Easily Put a Link to a PDF in an Article on Your Website

1. Save your file as a PDF then uploaded your PDF to your downloads page.
2. After you have saved it as a download, go to your downloads page and edit that download.
3. Towards the bottom, copy the link that says EMAIL EXECUTE FILE.
